Through financial assistance from the three Catholic parishes in Macon, the St. Vincent de Paul Society was able to help a 55-year old stroke victim with his Georgia Power bill. When meeting with him, we learned of additional ways that we could guide him to other agencies which might also help him. With our guidance, he was able to have a \$15,000 medical bill paid by Medicaid, had his food stamps reinstated, received free transportation to medical appointments, received food at the St. Vincent de Paul food pantry, and had his water bill paid. We went the extra mile to help this man get back on his feet. He seemed to be a wise man who wants to "stay awake" and face the problems of his changing situation.

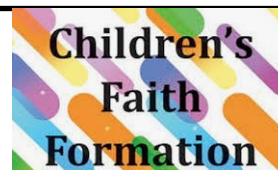
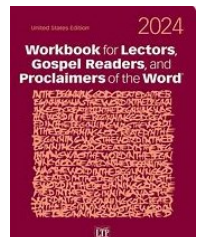
